Dear Participant,

Thank you for your interest in helping with our annual Fall Festival with a Christian-themed Trunk n Treat! This Fall Festival is an incredible opportunity to reach our community and we thank you for helping to make this possible. This is a traditional, safe, and fun event where participants decorate their vehicles or stations and distribute individually wrapped candy to the children in our community for a great time of fellowship. This year we have included “stations”, as some people may not have a vehicle to decorate, but would still like to participate by using other items such as a table. There is no cost to enter your trunk/station, however, there will be food and activities available for nominal fees.

Below please find some guidelines for participation:

- Decorations will focus on one of the Christian themes available for selection from the pre-approved list that the church will provide and should be geared towards young children. Be as creative as you like! Please remember to honor God with your costume/decor selections and that we are all representing Christ’s love to the community.
 - Specifically, please refrain from use of the following items in your décor choices: no witches/wizards, skeletons, guns, devils, scary, gory or creepy creatures.
 - Costumes are to be modest and appropriate - no low-cut, short, or revealing costumes.
- It is recommended that each participant bring 5-8 bags of individually wrapped candy to distribute. We will replenish your supply if you run low.
- Safety is a priority – no fireworks or flammable materials may be used.
- An adult must be present at all times and vehicles are to be turned off for the duration of the event.

Schedule:

- 6:30 pm – All vehicle/stations are to be ready by 6:30pm.
- 7:00 pm – The festival will be open to the community
- 8:00 pm – Brief message and prayer at the stage
 - All activities, including candy distribution, will pause at 8:00 pm.
 - Please direct guests to the stage area for a brief message and prayer.
- 9:00 pm – The festival will come to a close
 - All participants are asked to assist with clean-up and ensure their area is free of trash/décor/debris etc., and that all trash has been placed in a receptacle.
